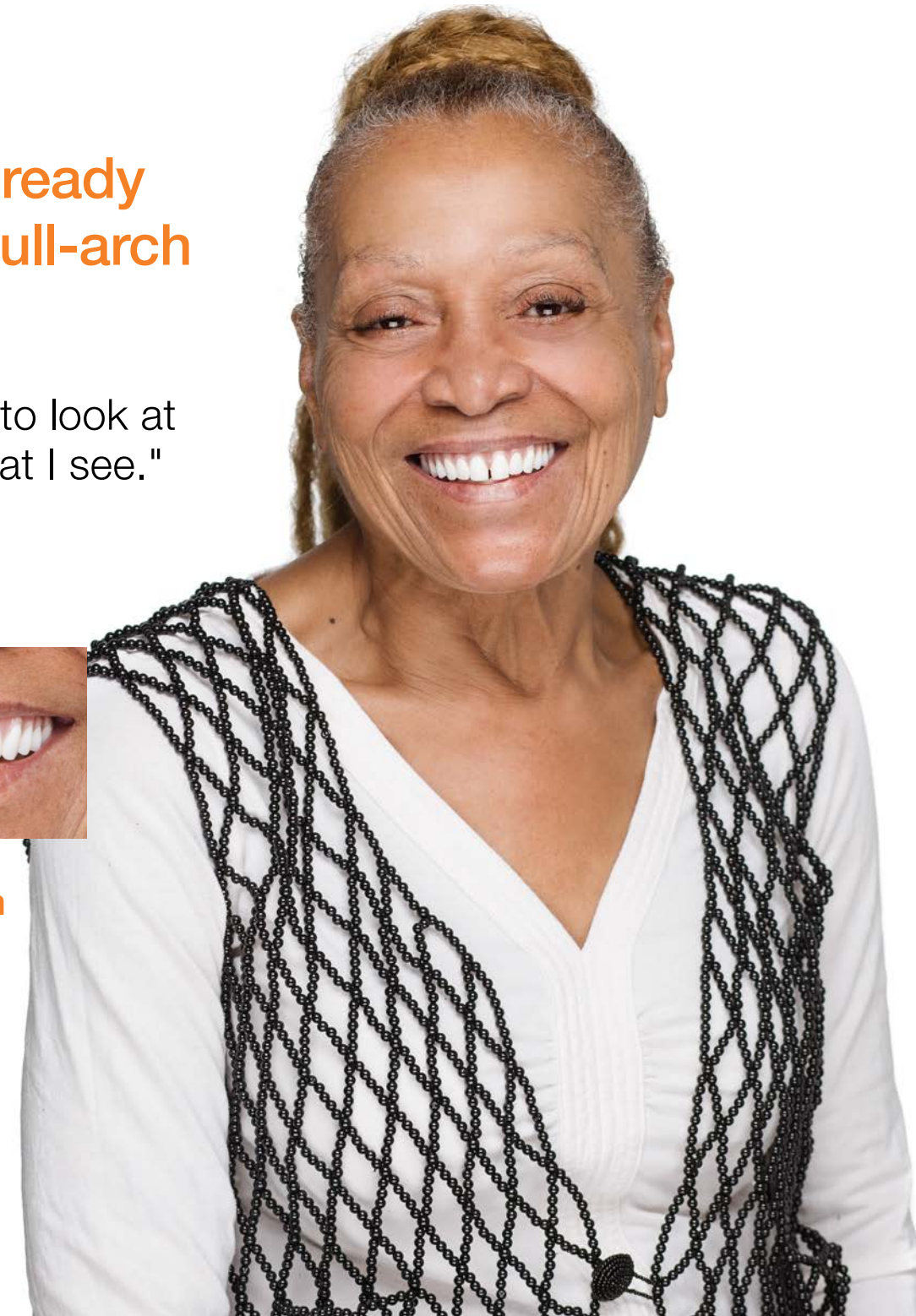

Dr. Sharafi attained his dental degree at the University of Maryland Dental School and finished his oral and maxillofacial surgery training at the University of Maryland Medical Center and R. Adam Cowley Shock Trauma Center. He has trained extensively in dentoalveolar, orthognathic, maxillofacial trauma and facial cosmetic surgeries as well as dental implants, reconstructive dental implantology and benign head and neck pathology. Dr. Sharafi has successfully performed over 2,000 full-arch, immediate-load procedures in his private practice and for a dental implant center, and he lectures internationally on a broad variety of topics including implants, full-arch reconstruction and bone grafting.
